2012 marks the **sesquicentennial** of the **U.S. Civil War**. Join us as we commemorate this major historic event by visiting President Abraham Lincoln's Springfield, IL home, tomb, and museum.

We will begin our Springfield day with a visit to the **Abraham Lincoln Home National Historic Site**. The two-story house, where the Lincolns lived for 17 years, has been carefully restored to its 1860's appearance, as have other neighborhood homes. Then walk across the street to visit the **First Presbyterian Church** the Lincolns attended. See the **Lincoln pew!** We will enjoy a delicious included lunch buffet at the **Chesapeake Seafood House** with a wonderful selection of seafood and meat. Afterward, we will drive through **Oak Ridge Cemetery** and visit Lincoln's magnificent tomb, and the impressive **State of Illinois World War II, Korean and Vietnam Memorials**. Next, we will visit the **New Lincoln Museum**. Combining impeccable scholarship and brilliant showmanship, the new Lincoln Museum's permanent exhibit galleries focus on twin journeys from a crude, overcrowded Indiana cabin to **Ford's Theatre** and a reproduction of the **House Chamber** in the **Old State Capital** where Lincoln's flag-draped casket lies in state. Along the way, you will be treated to a **stage and screen presentation ("Lincoln's Eyes")**, and a stunning **holographic theatre ("Ghosts of the Library")** which bring documents and artifacts, literally, to life, a treasures gallery housing icons like the **Gettysburg Address**; and a children's area called, "**Mrs. Lincoln's Attic**". Your tour cost includes all stated admission fees, lunch meal, step-on-guide, motor coach transportation, and professional tour manager.
